- Maintaining secondary sports and activities

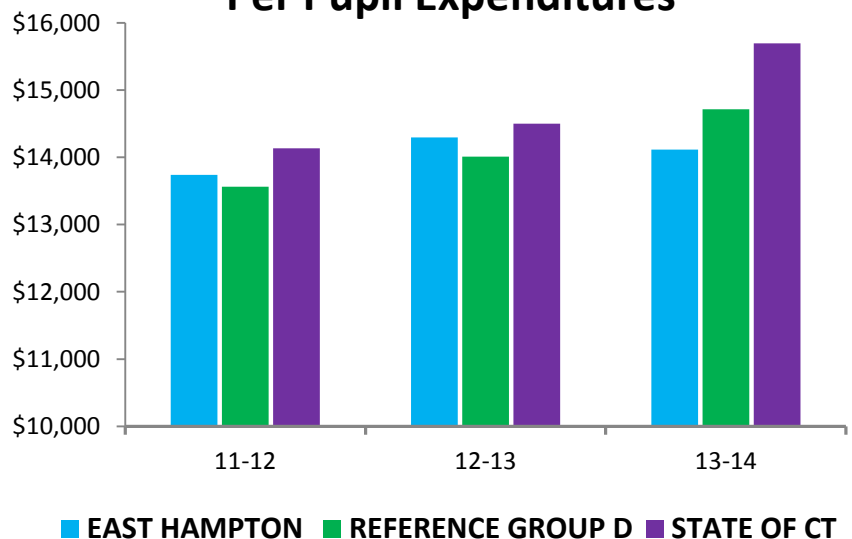
#### East Hampton Public Schools:
