About East Hampton Public Schools

East Hampton is located in Middlesex County, 20 miles south of the State Capitol of Hartford. It is equidistant from Boston and New York City—105 miles. It comprises 36.8 square miles and has a population of approximately 13,000. Conveniently located about 7 miles from two major highways Route 2 and 9, East Hampton's picturesque countryside along with it's beautiful lake, has proven attractive to those who seek a typical New England small town with easy access to city centers. This ambiance has made it one of Middlesex County's fastest growing towns.

East Hampton's Public Schools has approximately 2,076 students enrolled in grades Pre-K through 12. The school district is comprised of four schools: Memorial Elementary School (Pre-K-3) with an enrollment of approximately 630 students, Center Elementary School (4-5) with an enrollment of approximately 349 students, East Hampton Middle School (6-8) with an enrollment of approximately 476 students and East Hampton High School (9-12) with an enrollment of approximately 596 students.

The system has a proud history of providing a high quality education with an ongoing emphasis on student improvement. Programs are aimed at challenging all levels of students applying a strong inclusionary model to meet the needs of all children. Recent efforts in curriculum design, and introduction of higher order learning such as Everyday Math portend well for the districts progressive vision.
