

## **Administration**

### **Administrative Staff Organization**

The Superintendent of Schools shall organize the staff of the school system in a manner best suited to achieve its purposes. The Board of Education prefers a structure which establishes the Superintendent as a unitary executive responsible to the Board of Education, with lines of primary responsibility for all other employees clearly identified. There should be, in addition, provision for representative and deliberative groups of employees, students and community members whose functions, in the main, shall be to assist (1) in problem identification and solving, and (2) in evaluation of goal achievement.
