

Business/Non-Instructional Operations

Tuition Fees

The Board of Education may permit students from other school districts to attend the schools so long as there is room for them without undue crowding, and they or their sending district pays a tuition fee to be established by the Board of Education. The tuition fee may be changed as changes in cost indicate.

A tuition fee may be charged to resident and nonresident students when a course is offered outside the regular school hours.
