Sales & Disposal of Books, Equipment & Supplies

Disposition of Outdated Books

The Board of Education may, upon recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, authorize the disbursement or destruction of outdated textbooks which are no longer useful to the educational program, provided that such books are a minimum of ten years old and/or have been determined obsolete by the professional administrative staff.

Disposition of Obsolete Equipment & Supplies

The Superintendent of Schools or designee may authorize disposition of obsolete equipment. Equipment may not be sold directly to individuals. Any proceeds from disposition of equipment or supplies shall be deposited in the town general fund.
