### **Gifts, Grants and Bequests**

Gifts presented to the school system with a value of \$1,000.00 or more will be recognized by the Board of Education unless the donor requests otherwise through communication with the administration. All donors will be offered a receipt acknowledging their donation to the school system.

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To be acceptable, a gift must satisfy the following criteria:

1. Have a purpose consistent with the school system.
2. Be offered by a donor acceptable to the Board of Education.
3. Would not bring undesirable costs to the school system.
4. Will place no restrictions on the school program.
5. Will not imply endorsement of any business or product.
6. Will not be in conflict with any provision of state law or public law.

All gifts, grants and bequests shall become the property of the school system.

A letter of appreciation signed by the Chairperson of the Board of Education and/or by the Superintendent of Schools shall be sent to a donor unless otherwise indicated.
