

## **Bylaws of the Board**

### **Limits of Authority**

A Board member concerns himself/herself with questions of policy and delegates administration of policy to the Superintendent.

Individual members shall not represent the Board in any capacity not provided by law, except as authorized by a majority vote of the members at a duly called meeting, or by appointment of the Chairperson and endorsed by a majority of those present.
