Committee on Finance, Transportation, Buildings and Grounds

The duties of the finance, transportation, buildings & grounds committee shall include the review for recommendation to the Board of Education of the following:

1. Reviewing and analyzing the financial reports before presentation to the Board of Education;
2. Reporting to the Board of Education on various financial matters;
3. Requesting preparation of any special reports concerning the school system's financial statues as delegated by the Board of Education;
4. Applications for use of school property not covered by existing Board of Education policy;
5. Maintenance of school buildings and grounds, including at least an annual inspection;
6. Major repairs or improvements of school buildings and grounds;
7. Adequacy of insurance coverage;
8. Schedule of insurance premiums for ensuing year to be included in the budget;
9. Agent or agents of record for insurance;
10. Transportation of children, including negotiation of contract.

Committee on Personnel

The duties of the committee on personnel shall include the following:

1. The review for recommendations to the Board of Education of all personnel salary schedules and other personnel items requiring Board action;
2. Meetings with representatives of bargaining groups for negotiation purposes.

2. Conducting annual review of selected policies; and
3. Modifying policies in accordance with federal and state laws.
4. Reviewing and making recommendations concerning curriculum;
