

## **Bylaws of the Board**

### **Student Representatives**

The East Hampton Board of Education recognizes that a primary task of education is to create a stimulating learning climate which develops opportunities for students to be involved in real life experiences. The Board also recognizes the need to establish two-way communication with the elected representatives of the student body and to provide an opportunity for students to express concerns or opinions on educational problems.

The Board of Education authorizes the East Hampton High School Student Council to send a representative to all public meetings of the Board of Education. The student council representative shall sit with the Board of Education in general session, but shall not have a vote in Board of Education decisions. Representatives shall function within the guidelines established by the Board of Education, school administration and the East Hampton High School Student Council.
