

## **Bylaws of the Board**

### **Formulation, Adoption, Amendment of Policies**

The Board of Education shall adopt clearly defined written policies, based on a thorough understanding of the educational process. In formulating policies, the Board shall concern itself only with broad questions of policy and not with the administrative details of the operation of the public school system. The policies adopted by the Board shall be broad and general, and shall indicate a line of action to be taken by the Superintendent of Schools in dealing with the specific problems and issues. The application of such policies is an administrative detail to be performed by the Superintendent of Schools.

### **Amendment of Policy**

The policies of the Board shall be subject to amendment only upon a majority vote of the members of the Board present at a regular meeting, provided the wording of the previous policy and amendment thereof was considered at a previous meeting, or one week's written notice.
