

Community Relations

Soliciting Funds from and by Students

Fund drives by charitable organizations may be conducted in the school provided there is no use of subscription lists or other objectionable forms of suggested donation. All contributions shall be on an individual, voluntary basis. The purpose of this policy is to ensure that no child shall be embarrassed by the inability or unwillingness to contribute.

Employees shall use such drives to educate children in the understanding of the values and purposes of charitable organizations in the community.

Public Sales on School Property

The right to raise funds on the part of school-related organizations shall be retained by the Board of Education and/or the Superintendent through the school principal.

Any charitable collection must be approved annually by the Board of Education.

The Superintendent of Schools or designee may authorize student run concessions for the purpose of raising funds for school-related activities.

Student-Run Concessions

All concessions must be reviewed and approved annually by the administration.
