Otherwise Lawful Possession of Firearms on School Property

The issuance of a permit to carry a pistol or revolver does not authorize the possession or carrying of a pistol or revolver on property controlled by the school system. The Board of Education prohibits such possession on property controlled by the school system.

Possession of firearms for any reason are prohibited by the Board of Education (Section 53-3), whether otherwise lawful or not, in or on the real property comprising the public or private elementary or secondary school or at a school sponsored activity as defined in Subsection (h) of Section 10-233a.
