Career and Vocational Education

The East Hampton Board of Education expresses its commitment to the concept of career and vocational education and its infusion into the programs and services of its public schools, on every grade level (K-12).

The implementation of this commitment will result in the development of a broad sequence of learning experiences which will lead to appropriate accomplishment in the diverse roles demanded of all citizens in this participatory democracy: as learners, producers, family members, consumers, and informed and contributing citizens.

The Board further recognizes that the development and implementation of sound programs of career and vocational education requires the participation of the entire public school staff, together with the active support, expertise, resources and involvement of representatives from the professions, businesses, labor, industries, government and other societal sectors of the community. The Board will actively promote the development of partnerships among these groups for the consistent advancement of this policy, with assurance that a broad range of opportunities in vocational education will be made available for all secondary school students.
