The East Hampton Public Schools actively seek to locate, identify and refer children from birth to age 21 who require special education and related services in order to assist them and their families. Early childhood screenings are provided during the months of September, November, February and May. If you are concerned about a child's development, you are encouraged to contact Memorial Elementary School and request information about an Early Childhood Screening (860-365-4020). If the child is younger than three years of age, you may choose instead to contact the Connecticut Birth to Three System at 1-800-505-7000.
